Dear Brother Knights,

Easter is the celebration of a great and wondrous mystery — that Christ's Resurrection opens the way for the restoration of our humanity.

We just celebrated Easter, the feast of the Resurrection, the heart of the liturgical year. For 50 days, the Church extends the celebration of this incredible and wondrous mystery: The rising of Christ opens the way for the thorough restoration of our humanity.

Indeed, Christ's purpose was deeply personal. He came into the world not just to restore our wounded human dignity but to undo the effects of our individual sins and spiritual neglect. His divine restoration neglects no part of us. The Lord is out to re-create us, body and soul.

The Gospel reveals that Jesus knew human nature intimately, for it was through him we were made, and it was our nature that he assumed. Like an expert restorer, Jesus knows the repairs that need to be made, not just in our appearance, but in the core of our being. The Lord, in the power of the Spirit, empowers us to cleanse our consciences from sin, to purify and enlarge our hearts, and to take responsibility in advancing in holiness.

That is why, when the risen Lord appeared to the Apostles in the upper room, he gave them the power to forgive sins, a power that reaches us in the sacrament of reconciliation. That is also why, on the Second Sunday of Easter, we celebrate the Divine Mercy by which God forgives and restores us, his handiwork. He makes us shine outwardly with the beauty of inward truth, integrity and love. Happy Easter.
