Pro-Life Speaker

The Intentional Disciples (ID) group in our Family of Parishes sponsored a pro-life event on June 6. Mass was at 6:15, followed by a BBQ meal provided by our council with some food supplies provided by Right To Life members. The highlight of the event was a presentation by guest speaker Jonathon Van Maren.



He explained strategic approaches to influence our culture on life issues by learning from successful social reformers of the past. He used the examples of the Civil Rights movement, the end of slave trade movement, and child labour exploitation movement, all of which captured the attention of the media through the use of graphic pictures. He stressed that the pro-life movement should present anti-abortion abortion as a human rights violation. A workshop will be held in July for anyone wanting to receive training in presenting the pro-life view.

Thanks to council members Mike Lobsinger, Fern Pereira, Tony Rybka, Jim Gaylor, Paul Smith, and Gregg Bentley for preparing and serving the meal to about 80 people and to Paul Douros for organizing the presentation.
