### Chaplain's Message

Dear Brother Knights,

In the second reading this Sunday, James says, "What shall it profit, my brethren, if a man say he hath faith, but hath not works? If a brother or sister be naked, and want daily food and one of you say to them: Go in peace, be warmed and filled; yet give them not those things that are necessary for the body, what shall it profit? So faith also, if it have not works, is dead in itself."

This takes me be back to an article in this month's Columbia. Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly recalls being backstage at the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in July. The emcee in her remarks thanked the Knights of Columbus for their contribution to the Congress. The audience broke out in spontaneous applause.
