There wasn't a more widely recognizable member of council in the Stratford community than Harry Visser. He would joke that people avoided him when they saw him coming, usually on his bike, because he was notorious for selling tickets.

He was a shy person when he first joined council in 1993 but a course in self-confidence unlocked the outgoing, effervescent personality we have come to know.

He has occupied most of the key leadership positions in our council and initiated many activities that we carry on with today. After joining the council executive, he became GK in 2 years, moved on to the position of District Deputy, was Faithful Navigator of Justice J.M. King Assembly 1866, was Assemblies 4th Degree Commander, worked on Knights Incorporated looking after hall bookings and outside maintenance among

many other things.

He was a volunteer at the Stratford General Hospital where he greeted people for many years. It was Harry who convinced members to honour our deceased members by having the monument presently installed on the side of our building and arranged to have plaques mounted at the entrance to the hall listing deceased members. He volunteered to organize members to help install hockey boards on the Zehrs parking lot to help the Parkinson society with their annual fund raiser. He volunteered the Knights to be an integral part of the annual Relay for Life fundraiser for cancer research. Who can forget getting together on the first Saturday of June and cooking breakfast at 4:00 a.m. for 400-500 participants.
